How Does A Leadership Series Work?

The Family Leadership Series consists of three two-day workshops for a group of twenty to thirty parents/family members of a person(s) with disabilities.

Expenses are covered, including hotel lodging, all meals and stipends for transportation and respite care if needed.

Topics include:

- Initiative and Leadership: including information on the family support movement, leadership and the importance of family advocacy
- Creating a Vision: families are supported to "imagine better" and use their vision as a guide to their leadership and advocacy
- Policy Making at the Local, State and Federal Level: families learn how to use legislative change to create system-wide change
- Caring for the Care-Taker: families learn strategies to decrease stress and increase personal
