Jukebox Virtual Bingo FAQ

How do I sign up?

- 1. Purchase your tickets (1 per player) at www.hmea.org/jukebox-bingo
- 2. Follow the link on the confirmation screen to complete your registration
- 3. You will receive your link to the trivia game, from Rob Peters Entertainment, that will be hosted on Zoom

Why do I need 2 devices?

- 1 device to log into Zoom where the live game is played and hosted by Rob Peters
- 1 device to log into the bingo website where you will access your electronic bingo cards
- Devices can be any combination of computer, laptop, tablet, or smart phone but must have internet access

Does everyone in my house need 2 devices?

No, all players in your house can view the Zoom game on one computer, but they will need their own device to play their unique bingo cards.

What happens on game night?

- Join Zoom, a few minutes before 7:00, using the Zoom link information you were sent from Rob Peters Entertainment.
- When the game is ready to begin, Rob will give you a website to go to where you will access your bingo cards. You will be asked to enter a username; you can get creative and use a fun alias/nickname.
- You will hear Rob play a song and then you will have 10 seconds to see if that song is on your bingo card. You can still mark the song on your card after the 10 seconds, but you get more points for answering quicker and points may count in the event of a tie.
- The game has 4 bingo cards

Can we play as a team?

No, there are no teams and only one winner for each bingo card.

Do I have to have my webcam and mic on during the game?

All webcams and mics will automatically be turned off, but you will be able to chat with other players in the chat window.
